**FUMIGATION PROCEDURE NOTICE TO RESIDENTS**

NOTE: You will be required to vacate the property upon the arrival of the fumigation crew. Brooker Pest Control, Inc. reserves the right to reschedule treatment in the event of adverse weather conditions.

**PREPARATION FOR TENT FUMIGATIONS**

1. You should plan to be out of your structure(s) for two nights. You may enter the structure(s) on the third day when our CLEARANCE NOTICE is posted on your door.
2. All people, living plants and pets (including fish aquariums) must be REMOVED from the structure(s).
3. The law requires that all structures be locked during fumigation. We must be provided with keys for ALL LOCKED areas. It is important that you make arrangements prior to fumigation with the company representative. Keys will be returned to you when the job is completed.
4. All food, feed and medications must be REMOVED from the structure(s). This includes the contents of all refrigerators and freezer systems. Remove all dairy products including milk and ice cream.
5. Remove all mattresses and pillows with waterproof covers such as mattresses for infants or sickroom. If the covers are removable it is only necessary then to remove the covers. No extra precautions are necessary for waterbeds.
6. Electricity must be available; however, all heating elements, water heaters, heaters, pianos, organs and instant-on-TV's must be unplugged and all air conditioning units turned off.
7. All pilot lights must be extinguished and the gas turned off at the main valve. Please make arrangements to have the gas turned back on and pilot lights lit upon your return.
8. To insure proper fumigation and aeration of your structure(s), all cabinets and closets must be opened at least four inches and all drawers stepped. Raise blinds, open drapes and open all attic or crawl space accesses.
9. Any outside plants closer than twelve inches to the structure(s) or any vines attached to the structure(s) must be removed. Shrubbery and tree branches should be cut back. Water heavily all vegetation located alongside the structure(s).
10. During the treatment process, it is necessary for our crews to work on the roof. Although extreme caution is used, Brooker Pest Control, Inc. will not be responsible for damage to the roof, cracked/broken tiles, gutters, awnings, antennas, neon signs, screened areas, plant life or solar heaters. NOTE: Tar/Paint should not be applied within one week prior to the fumigation to allow an adequate drying period. Mobile homes are subject to the above conditions.
11. Brooker Pest Control, Inc. will not be held responsible for vandalism, theft or breaking and entering during the fumigation and aeration procedure. If you are concerned, we recommend you obtain a watchman or guard during the fumigation and aeration procedure at the customer's expense.

**ADDITIONAL PRECAUTIONS FOR METHYL BROMIDE FUMIGATION**

1. The following materials must be removed from the structure(s) as they may develop an undesirable odor: furs, woolen materials high protein flour, cereals, articles with horsehair, iodized salt, all patent leather articles, foam and sponge rubber goods, washing detergents, photographic chemicals, charcoal products, and any other sulfur-containing products.

## **UPON RE-ENTRY**

2. DO NOT ENTER the structure(s) unless our CLEARANCE NOTICE is posted on your door.
3. No dishes, pots, pans, clothing or linens need to be washed.
4. Since the gas leaves no residue, any crawling insect can immediately re-enter the structure(s). In some cases, buildings have an invasion of ants right after a fumigation attracted by the dead insects.
5. Upon re-entry you may still see termite droppings. This does not indicate a live termite infestation , but merely old feces emptying from tunnels due to building vibrations. This is expected in most structures and should not cause concern.
